****** Recommended Yearly Maintenance for Your ShowerStick

To keep your ShowerStick performing at its best and extend the life of the softening resin, it's important to loosen the resin inside the ShowerStick at least once per year. If you use well water or water with a high iron content (rusty color), this process should be done 2–3 times per year.

This procedure should also be followed if:

- The ShowerStick has been **stored** for any period of time.
- Saltwater won't pour in during regeneration.
- The main water supply has been turned off, then back on.

Purpose of This Maintenance

Over time, the softening resin inside the ShowerStick can become compacted, reducing efficiency. Shaking the ShowerStick helps **loosen the resin beads**, restoring optimal water flow and softening performance.

For ShowerSticks Installed With a Hanger

(For orders placed after December 8, 2024, or if a hanger has been added to an earlier unit)

- 1. Remove the **hose from the bottom** of the ShowerStick (ensure the washer remains inside the hose).
- 2. Unscrew the **short hose from the top**, then remove the ShowerStick from the hanger.
- 3. Hold the ShowerStick **horizontally** with both hands and **shake to loosen** the resin.
- 4. Hold it **vertically**, shake again, and repeat in the **opposite direction** until you hear the resin moving freely.
- 5. Insert the ShowerStick back into the hanger
- 6. Check that the washer is **flat inside the end of the short hose**, then re-attach it to the **top** of the ShowerStick. **Do not over-tighten**.
- 7. Check that the washer is **flat inside the end of the long hose**, then re-attach it to the **bottom** of the ShowerStick.
- 8. **Regenerate** your ShowerStick as usual.

For ShowerSticks Installed Without a Hanger

(For orders placed before December 9, 2024)

- 1. Remove the **hose from the bottom** of the ShowerStick (keep the washer inside the hose).
- 2. Detach the ShowerStick from the assembly, **keeping the regeneration port cap attached**.
- 3. Hold the ShowerStick horizontally with both hands and shake to loosen the resin.
- 4. Then hold it **vertically**, shake again, and repeat in the **opposite direction** until you hear the resin moving freely.
- 5. Remove any **old plumber's tape** from the male fitting on top of the ShowerStick and apply **new tape** (wrap **clockwise 4 times**).
- 6. Reattach the ShowerStick to the assembly hand tighten snugly (do not over-tighten).
- 7. Make sure the washer is inside the hose and is lying **flat**, then re-attach the hose to the bottom of the ShowerStick.
- 8. **Regenerate** your ShowerStick as usual.

Maintenance Summary

- Frequency: Once a year (or 2–3 times yearly for well or iron-heavy water).
- Goal: Loosen compacted resin and restore optimal softening performance.
- When else to do it: After storage, regeneration issues, or water shutoffs.
